3. Is there any quantified emission reduction target in your sector?
  - If yes, specify target year and reduction amount
    - How the achievement in emission reduction is monitored, existence of measurable indicators?
    - is there any systematic data available for emission reduction?
  - If not, Is there any study on emission reduction potential in your sector?
    - If yes, is there any data available for emission reduction potential?
4. Do existing climate policies/strategies are consistent with sector's development objectives related to GHG mitigation in building, waste, transportation and agriculture sectors?
5. Do 22 climate related policies/strategies (please see Summary of initial findings table attached) include most important relevant documents?
6. Do any additional existing national or sectoral policy/strategy documents should be also reviewed?
7. Do you know about any relevant and important national or sectoral policy/strategy documents currently under preparation or planning?
8. What is your opinion/suggestions regarding necessity of the preparation of specific national or sectoral low carbon development policy/strategy documents?
